

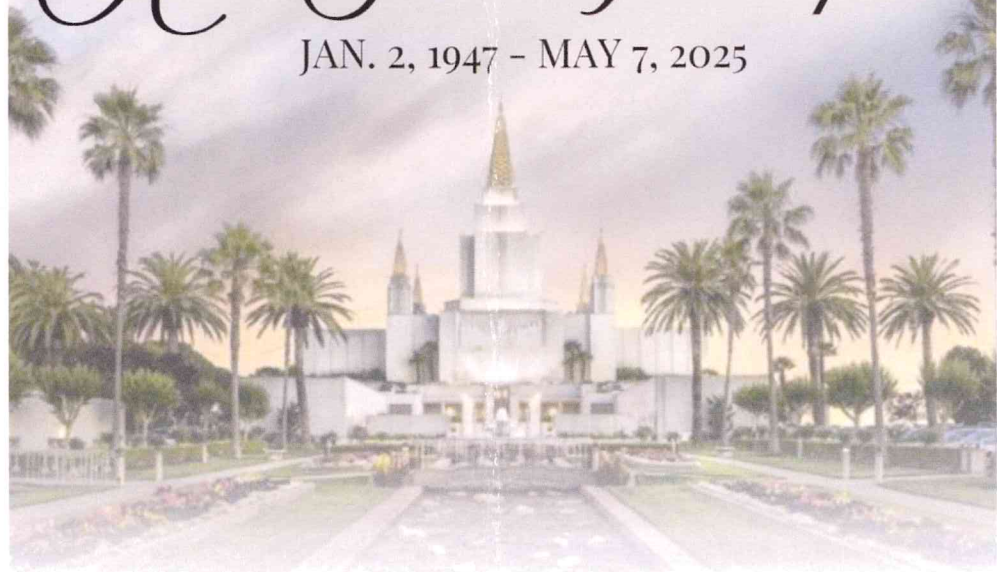

# Ana Siale Tu'itupou

BORN IN THE VILLAGE OF HOUMA, VAVA'U TO VAISIMA SIALE AND SIOELI MAAMALOA. 'ANA SIALE TUL TUPOU LIVED A LIFE OF PURPOSE AND UNWAVERING FAITH. SHE PURSUED HER EARLY EDUCATION BEFORE CONTINUING HER STUDIES IN SIULIKUTAPU, VAVA'U. SHE LATER GRADUATED WITH HIGH HONORS (MAAMALOA LOUMAILE) FROM QUEEN SALOTE COLLEGE. A TESTAMENT TO HER DEDICATION AND LOVE FOR LEARNING.

HER PASSION FOR EDUCATION LED HER TO THE TONGA TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE, FOLLOWED BY FURTHER STUDIES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC IN FIJI. UPON HER RETURN TO TONGA, ANA DEDICATED HER LIFE TO LEARNING, BEGINNING HER TEACHING CAREER AT TU'ALIKU 'O PILOLEVU PRIMARY SCHOOL AND VARIOUS PRIMARY SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT HER DECADES OF TEACHING. SHE WOULD LATER RETIRE AS A RESPECTED SCHOOL PRINCIPAL IN 2001.

IN 1967, 'ANA MARRIED THE LOVE OF HER LIFE, MELINO TU'ITUPOU OF FATUMU. TOGETHER, THEY RAISED A BEAUTIFUL FAMILY OF SIX CHILDREN, WHERE THEY INSTILLED THE IMPORTANCE OF FAITH, LOVE, AND HARD WORK. AFTER MELINO'S PASSING IN 1992,

'ANA CARRIED ON WITH STRENGTH CONTINUING TO LEAD BOTH IN HER PROFESSION AND HER HOME AS A DEVOTED WIDOW FOR 33 YEARS.

EVENTUALLY, SHE MADE HER WAY TO THE UNITED STATES, SETTLING IN SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA. IN 2006, SHE WAS BAPTIZED A MEMBER OF THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS, AND LATER SEALED FOR TIME AND ALL ETERNITY TO HER ETERNAL COMPANION.
